The following describes **Maui's "Coach's Honor System"** referenced in the Meet Notices for MAGSA meets. These agreements are between MAGSA teams. This honor system is not part of the meet notice as an enforceable item, and therefore not subject to fines or disqualification when exceptions are granted, or mistakes are made during entries.

If the CoC or other officials notice unstated exceptions to these rules, swimmers may be moved to other events or removed from said event during the scratching process. (An attempt will be made to contact the coach.)

**Note:** Since this agreement is not part of the meet notice, teams from outside MAGSA are not subject to these restrictions.

- If an event is offered in a swimmers age group in a session of a MAGSA meet, they should swim in that age group and not in the Open or other comparable event.
- In 50-meter competition, Swimmers in any 10-u event, are limited to 3 events in a meet. (10-u events are intended for beginner swimmers. They are generally noted as 10-u vs 10U on the MAGSA schedule. 10-u events usually are an offering next to a full 10U event in the same session of the same meet.)
- In 25-yard competition, Swimmers in any 9-10 or 8&U event, are limited to 3 events in a meet. (9-10 and 8&U events are intended for beginner swimmers. These events usually are an offering next to a full 10U event in the same session of the same meet.)
- Some 13&Over events have been extended to 11-12 events in the meet notices and in the TM meet file – events NOT swum at Hawaiian State Champs such as 200 Fly, 200 Back, 200 Breast, 400 IM, 800m Free, 1000yd Free, 1500m Free, 1650yd Free. These events are **ONLY** to be swum by 11-12 swimmers from MAGSA teams when:
  - A swimmer will be “aging up” to 13-14 before the next state championship meet.
  - A swimmer needs a qualifying time or practice race before a mainland competition that offers this event.
  - A swimmer **MUST** have an “A” time (the coach’s word based on a practice time is acceptable for this if no other time is available) in the 13-14 age group for that event.
