[Coach Soichi Sakamoto Pool](#)

8 lane 50m Pool w/1m,3m diving boards.

Located next to War Memorial Stadium & Gymnasium, Bald-win High School, our Aquatics office and across from Maui Memorial Hospital.



Named for legendary Maui Swim Coach Soichi Sakamoto who developed many Olympic champions in the 30's & 40's. "Maui Ditch kids" trained in the Irrigation ditches using repeat & wind-sprint techniques. Coach Sakamoto brought these revolutionary training techniques to the world and are the standard today.

10 lane 25 yd 4-5 ft depth (Opened 1992)

Located below the Kahului Community Center, this shallow pool is great for Lap & Learn to swim.

6 lane 25 yard 4 to 9 ft depth

Right by Kahului PO and old Salvation Army, this enclosed pool is great for lap swim, aerobics and Learn to swim.

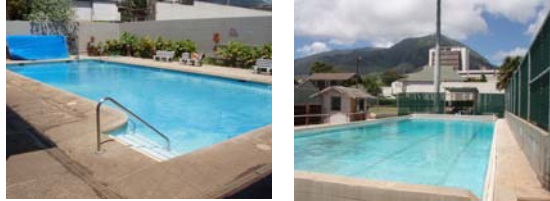

For those who count ... a mile is 1760 yards (1609.3m) or 70.4 lengths in a 25y pool & 32.2 lengths in a 50m pool. A standard "competition" mile is 1650 yards (66 lengths) or 1500m (30 lengths of 50m pool). Lahaina, Sakamoto & Kihei are usually 50m March-Jun/Jul and 25yd Jul/Aug-Feb for Age Group & HS swimming.

[New/Old Wailuku Pools](#)

NW: No lanes 15 yd 3½-4 ft depth w/ side handrails. OW: 3 lane 25 yd 3½-9 ft.



These two pools are located at the corner of Market and Wells Streets in Wailuku across from Lao School. New Wailuku is kept a little warmer than most and is thought of by some as a "Therapeutic Pool".

Maui has one county multi-pool facility located at the Kihei Community Center near the Tech-nology Park.

[Kihei Aquatic Center](#)

3 Pools: 8-lane 50m by 25yd Competition Pool with 1m & 3m diving boards; 8-lane 25x30 yd shallow (3½-4 ft) Training Pool & a 10x30ft Keiki pool w/fountain.

Three pools serve the community and Local/World class swim & water polo competitions with a shallow training pool great for Learn to Swim and Water Aerobics, and large keiki pool. (Opened 1999)

[Upcountry/Pukalani-East Side](#)

Maui has one county pool Upcountry at 1400 feet that is part of the Mayor Hannibal Tavares Community Center in Pukalani.

[Upcountry Swimming Complex](#)

3 Pools: 6-lane 50m x 45 ft Pool w/1m diving boards 4-13ft deep; 40x40 ft Teaching Pool 3-3½ ft deep; and a small 1 ft deep keiki pool.

This swimming complex boasts the best view that boosts the spirit as you exercise or play. The lap swim pool is not used for competition, but many adult, age group and high school swim & water polo teams and aerobic groups share training time here. The teaching + Keiki pools are perfect for the very young beginning swimmer. (Opened 1997)

Maui has one facility located at the Recreation Center as you enter Lahaina.

[Lahaina Aquatic Center](#)

2 Pools: 8-lane 50m x 25yd 4-6ft Competition Pool. 15x20ft keiki pool & fountain.

The pool complex in Lahaina has hosted International, State and Local swim & water polo competitions AND supports the community with both a shallow and deep area in the main pool great for swimming, water polo, Learn to Swim and Water Aerobics. Plus there is a relatively large Keiki pool with a fountain. (Opened 1993)
