MEET FLOW/
MANAGEMENT: **A USMS (Masters) meet will be held concurrently at this same location.**
Events will alternate between Age group (all age groups 8u, 10u, 11-12, 13-18) and Masters to allow enough rest for swimmers in both meets. USA Swimming meets require ages 12 and under to complete all swims in UNDER 4 hours. **If there are many 12 & under entries for this meet, the swimming order of events will be altered accordingly. If there are a small number of entries, the meet will be delayed to assure a 20-minute minimum between swims.**

WARM-UP: Warm-ups and warm-downs must be supervised by a USA swimming registered “Coach Member” following guidelines established by the LSC. **Supervising deck coaches shall have their USA Swimming Registration card prominently displayed at all times.** The registration chairperson will enforce registration rules regarding coaches. Disregard of the USA Swimming safety rules will be grounds for disqualification of swimmer from competition. **Warm-up lanes will be marked and kept separate from the separately sanctioned USMS meet being held at the same location.**

DIVISIONS: 8&Under, 10&Under, 11-12, 13-14, 15-16, 17-18. 13-18 will be seeded together.

RULES: Current USA Swimming and Hawaiian Swimming rules will govern meet.

FORMAT: Cardless, timed finals, using Colorado Timing Systems electronic timing system with touch pads and buttons and manual stop watch back-up. The four (4) hour rule will be in effect for swimmers in the 12 and under age groups.

EVENTS: See Attached.

ELIGIBILITY: All swimmers must be currently USA Swimming registered and their registration numbers must be on the master entry form or disk file. **No deck registration will be accepted and all new registrations must be mailed directly to the LSC Registrar and postmarked no later than 5 days before the meet date.**

ENTRIES: Swimmers are encouraged to swim all 5 events. (The idea of a Pentathlon is to

add up all the times and see who's total is least.)

- ENTRY FEES: A report of entries will be sent to each club and to the LSC Treasurer prior to the start of this meet. This report will serve as a method to calculate the required LSC fee for each club due at the end of the Short Course MAGSA qualifying season and at a rate of \$1 per swimmer entered added up for all sanctioned MAGSA meets. Each club will be responsible to pay this fee to the LSC treasurer with a check to "HAWAIIAN SWIMMING." Also see MAGSA's "No Show" policy
- DEADLINE: Team Manager Entries must be RECEIVED NO LATER than 6:00pm Monday, August 18th, 2008 – other entries by Sunday August 19th. NO late entries will be accepted at the meet.

- CHECK-IN: Check-in sheets will be given to coaches for verification. **Coaches will need to present their credentials to pick up check-in sheets; exceptions must see the meet referee.** Coaches are to verify their swimmers and scratch events as appropriate. Sheets must be returned to the Clerk of Course one (1) hour before start of meet.
- SCORING: Individual events will not be scored. Final times from each swim will be added together to determine final placement.
- AWARDS: Awards will be donated by Masters Swimming and given to the top swimmer in each age group for the TOTAL time of ALL 5 events.
- RESULTS: Hard copy of meet results will be provided upon request only. Results will be emailed to all participating teams with known email addresses and will be posted on Hawaiian Swimming & Maui Dolphins websites.
- OFFICIALS: Each team is required to provide one official for every five swimmers entered in the meet. For those clubs entered with less than five swimmers, at least one official will be required. Timers are considered officials.
- REFEREE: Due to the nature of this meet (concurrent with a USMS meet at the same pool, with separate warm-up areas, and with possibly alternating events), the meet referee for this event will not double as any official in the USMS meet.
